1.	Introduction and Apologies Those present were welcomed to today's virtual meeting and introductions were made. It was noted that CF was chairing today's meeting. Apologies for today's meeting were acknowledged as above.

3.	Matters Arising from the Minutes of Previous Meeting 4.1 With reference to Aurora SB commented on the speed and issues with inspections and permits. EH advised that he had experienced the same problems with permits being vague. AS then informed that he also had encountered the same issues. DA stated that when using the mobile app that he had experienced issues when downloading data.

<p>4.2</p>	<p>Programme of Major Works & General Co-ordination</p> <p>Stirling Council – SB All Stirling Council work are on Aurora, major works will begin in January 2021 on Stevenson Bridge with subsequent road closures, also works beginning on new cycle lanes in and around Stirling City centre.</p> <p>Falkirk Council – EH informed that Falkirk Council were at present working through their programme of comprehensive carriageway jobs.</p> <p>Clackmannanshire Council – SW advised that work would commence in the following location within Clackmannanshire :-</p> <p>Tullibody cross roads - October 2020, School Road/Park Place, Tullibody - January 2021, A91, Stirling Road, Alva - January 2021 and A907 Clackmannan Bypass - Easter 2021.</p> <p>DA then informed of 2 sets of works that will have an impact on the local area :- M80 Nethermains Road - 21st October - 25th October and M876 Bowtrees - 24th October - 31st October, where there will be 3 diversion routes in place.</p> <p>MG advised of forthcoming resurfacing programmes and advised that he would email CF with details of contracts. MG also advised that BEAR NW and NE Contracts are back to full operating capacity. Colin Watson has replaced Tommy Deans as Network Manager in the NW now that Tommy has left for the South east Contract. Alan Campbell will replace Colin as NE Network Manager.</p>	
<p>4.3</p>	<p>Performance Indicators</p> <p>Stirling Council – SB advised that there had been an issue with the indicators that DC had printed off. Any issues and Stirling Council will speak to the utilities individually.</p> <p>Falkirk Council – EH informed he would contact utility companies as required.</p> <p>Clackmannanshire Council – SW advised that he would share details on indicators with utility companies after today's meeting. SW further advised that ratings overall were poor.</p>	
<p>4.4</p>	<p>Traffic Sensitivity, Proposed Changes to Road Designations and Engineering Difficulties</p> <p>Stirling Council – SB advised that for Stirling Council there were no changes at the moment.</p> <p>DA informed of changes and further advised that an exercise would be carried out over a number of years.</p>	

4.5	<p>National Street Gazateer</p> <p>Stirling Council – SB advised that he had spoken with Caroline Stewart with regards to the migration of the system from roundnet to idocs. CF advised that everything was in place and that the meeting with idocs had been positive.</p> <p>Clackmannanshire Council – SW informed that shortly this would go out to tender to obtain a solution. SW further advised that the turnaround should hopefully be before 1st February.</p>	CS to update
4.6	<p>Reinstatement, Signing & General Safety Issues</p> <p>Stirling Council – SB updated that there had been signing issues with regards to Scottish Water. The first location was Cotton Row, Deanston, where SB advised that there was no communication with Stirling Council and Stirling Bus Station in relation to a manhole whereby a bus was required to be diverted. The second location was Spittal Street, Stirling which is a one way street. SB advised that this area had subsequently flooded and that the diversion signs put in place by Scottish Water were inadequate with a poor route implemented.</p> <p>With regards to Spittal Street, EW advised that she would look into this issue.</p> <p>Falkirk Council – EH advised that he had nothing to add to this item at present.</p> <p>Clackmannanshire Council – SW asked utility companies to have a wider look of areas. SW made an example of works concerning cul-de-sacs in Clackmannanshire whereby residents have had no communication from utility companies. These residents have subsequently encountered issues whilst entering and exiting their streets.</p>	EW to update

SB further advised that a list had been emailed to Scottish Water.</p> <p>Falkirk Council – EH stated that the following notices were waiting to be accepted :- Virgin - Earls Road, Grangemouth, LA ref 2710739 and Mayfield Drive, Longcroft LA 278197, BT - The Vennel, Denny, LA ref 2621138 and Scottish Water - High Street, Bonnybridge, LA Ref 2626275.</p> <p>JD advised that he would email Scottish Water and BT with regards to details.</p> <p>Clackmannanshire Council - SW advised of Scottish Power issue at B9140 Pitfair Road, Fishcross. SW further informed that water had been coming up through the road for a period of 6 months, and that this was a concern as winter was approaching. IF advised that he will get back to SW with regards to this.</p>	IF
