Major Projects	 Openreach – Government backed R100 Fibre Upgrade taking place in several areas in West of Scotland, contact has been made with Authorities and current locations have been shared. Scottish Water – All current projects should be on the system. SP Energy – All planned works in Aurora DM – Usually notify for all road closures is this going forward only for major projects. Roads Authority Programmes COB shared a planned worked reports, showing all planned major and restrictive works until 2023.
