4.2	<p>Programme of Major Works & General Co-ordination</p> <p>Falkirk – EH advised capital work programme notices have been raised.</p> <p>UCI World Cycling Championships Mens Elite race various road closures and spate events planned.</p> <p>23rd September – All Under One Banner public procession. Route to be confirmed.</p> <p>24th June – Public procession by The Grand Lodge of the East.</p> <p>Clacks – GM advised all notices in Aurora.</p> <p>Stirling – WC advised UCI World Cycling Championships various routes and embargoes within Stirling from 1st – 14th of August. All embargoes on Aurora. Routes to be circulated with minutes.</p> <p>Walk , Cycle, Live Stirling works ongoing in City Centre</p> <p>Stirling Station Gateway project also on going in City Centre.</p> <p>All works notified on register.</p> <p>VM – AM advised work streams have been forwarded to relevant authorities.</p> <p>Network Rail – DM advised of upcoming works all in the SRWR.</p>	
4.3	<p>Performance Indicators</p> <p>Stirling – Issues with SPEN in past quarter. Discussed with SPEN at the time and monitoring.</p> <p>Issue with SGN. Monitoring required.</p> <p>Falkirk – Issues with the defect inspection figures for Virgin Media and SGN.</p> <p>Clacks – No issues</p>	
4.4	<p>Traffic Sensitivity, Proposed Changes to Road Designations and Engineering Difficulties</p> <p>Stirling Council – No Changes</p> <p>Falkirk Council – No Changes</p> <p>Clackmannanshire Council – No Changes</p>	
4.5	<p>National Street Gazetteer</p> <p>No update given – no one on the meeting is involved in this group.</p>	

4.6	<p>Reinstatement, Signing & General Safety Issues</p> <p>Falkirk – EW raised the issue of reinstatement times being excessive. Particular issue Scottish Water / Clancy Docwra sites not being reinstated in a timely manner. Recent example of Dean Road where a 2 week notice was issued with works not being undertaken until the second week and an extension being requested.</p> <p>Stirling - GB raised the issue of manual control not being undertaken despite permit stating as conditions.</p> <p>Issue with BT / Openreach LA REF 3247611 – Site meeting took place, works were agreed then changed once the site was live. This caused a conflict with nearby works.</p> <p>Clacks – No issues.</p>	
5.	<p>Outstanding Defects/Defective Apparatus</p> <p>Falkirk - EH advised BT / Openreach (LA Ref 3176592) reinstatement failure as material used was not to specification. Passed to BT / Openreach.</p> <p>Virgin Media defects in Bo’Ness</p> <p>Stirling – GB advised Scottish Water have an outstanding defect (LA ref 2725040) since 2019.</p> <p>SGN defects under references 3078724/2969247 passed to Nichola Millar</p> <p>SPEN D2 inspection 2566907 failed SC inspection in 2021. Passed to IF.</p> <p>Clacks – GM advised various outstanding fire hydrants.</p> <p>Nichola Millar (SGN) – Advised SGN are meeting with reinstatement contractor to programme defects.</p>	
6.	<p>Matters arising from RAUC</p> <p>No matters arising from previous RAUCs.</p>	
7.	<p>Matters Arising from ERAUC / WRAUC</p> <p>EH advised no issues from East RAUC</p> <p>WC advised no issues from WRAUC</p>
