10.	<ul> <li>A repair was carried at Carrickarden Road, Bearsden by SGN after they damaged a drainage carrier pipe during mains replacement works, the repair was found to be of a poor standard when CCTV was used by EDC to inspect the repair, Helen will confirm tomorrow when this will be done and advise Alan who will pass this to Team.</li> <li>AH-Stated that he has asked Road Inspectors when taking pictures of defective apparatus to take a few – immediate of defect and surroundings as this will make it easier to locate the site.</li> <li>MJ-Asked that utilities advise NLC if they aren't receiving pictures along with report as Inspectors have been asked to do this routinely.</li> <li>AH- Confirmed National Coring Programme is now in final stages with lan and Lynsey preparing the final report. Once this is complete AH will prepare invoices and send to all authorities in the south west area.</li> <li>JH-referred to temporary traffic management and queried where those near schools being manually controlled have to be done so just at peak times or continually. This is obviously not cost effective to have someone there all day long. CS will clarify with the traffic officer and report back.</li> <li>JH- queried full and half panel reinstatement sizes on roads still under restriction. Discussion took place around this and Utilities asked for confirmation on this. AH will speak with Stewart Grainger, TL Operations and will report back at next meeting.</li> <li>EW – SW finding increase in valve chambers being choked following resurfacing works therefore have asked that all chambers are checked for debris and remove this as it causes delays to repairs and can incur additional cost.
